Financial members (as at 12th August 2022) are invited to contribute in the following way:

- 1. Read the profile for the nominee for President, Rachel Chapman.**
 - Vote in favour, or not in favour, for Rachel Chapman as President of IYTA (NZ) for 2022/2023.
- 2. Read the annual financial statement.**
 - Vote to agree, or not agree, to accept the report.
- 3. Life Membership nominations:** none received this year.
- 4. IYTA Constitution** – please see comments that were made on this at an NE meeting in Nov 2021. To be able to move forward with making amends, this must be agreed by members.
 - Vote to agree, or not agree, to accept the report.
